Don Weobong is founder and president of Telania, LLC, based in Louisville, Ky. A native of Ghana, Mr. Weobong's interest in international business began with educational studies at the Institute of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators (ICSA) in the United Kingdom, with subsequent studies in France.

Mr. Weobong immigrated to the United States in 1997 where he completed his undergraduate studies at Spalding University in Louisville in 2000, followed by earning an MBA at Bellarmine University, also in Louisville.

The blueprint for eLeaP Learning Management System, the cornerstone product of Telania, was developed during Mr. Weobong's graduate studies at Bellarmine University.

In 2008 Mr. Weobong released the book, *How to Sell Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) - SaaS Sales Training System*, described as "the definitive guide to understanding, selling, and marketing software-as-a-service in a Web 2.0 world."

eLeaP is currently being used by more than 450 companies internationally, with 150,000 course lessons created to date through the eLeaP software platform.

Telania is named after his ancestral village in Ghana. Mr. Weobong and his family support education and schools for more than 550 children in his native Ghana through the St. Benedict's School.

Mr. Weobong also sits on the boards of several non-profit organizations in his community and is a member of many national trade organizations. Mr. Weobong speaks French, English, and his tribal language Kasem.
